Boxer Eligibility

Age Requirements:

All boxers participating in the AIBA Youth Men and Women World Boxing Championships 2018 must be born between January 1, 2000 and December 31, 2001.

Medical Requirements:

To be eligible to participate in the AIBA Youth Men and Women World Boxing Championships 2018, all boxers must satisfy the medical requirements according to the AIBA Technical Rules and AOB Competition Rules (<http://www.aiba.org/aiba-technical-competition-rules/>).

Additional IF Requirements:

To be eligible to participate in the AIBA Youth Men and Women World Boxing Championships 2018, all boxers must:

- Have competed in one (1) of the continental qualifying events in 2018
- Satisfy the nationality and eligibility requirements according to the AOB Competition Rules and AIBA Technical Rules

Men Qualification Pathway

- For each qualifying event, the qualification places obtained for the AIBA Youth Men and Women World Boxing Championships 2018 will be allocated to the men boxers according to the table below, which shows the overall distribution of all quotas by continent:

Women Qualification Pathway

Registrations to the AIBA Youth Men and Women World Championships 2018 will be opened to all women boxers who have competed in their respective Youth Continental Championships 2018 but limited to 174 entries.

If the limit of 174 women boxers is exceeded by the end of registration period, AIBA will consider the following maximum of entries per category:

In the weight categories where the limit is exceeded by the end of registration period, Boxers will be selected as per the following procedure:

1. Priority will be given to boxers who have won at least 1 bout in their respective Youth Continental Championships 2018. Boxers who were registered but did not have the opportunity to compete due to lack of participants in their category will be selected.
2. If the limit in the category is still exceeded, the qualification places obtained for the AIBA Youth Men and Women World Boxing Championships 2018 will be allocated to the boxers according to the table below, which shows the overall distribution of all quotas by continent:

- The Host Country must confirm to AIBA, in a form of an official letter, the use of the Host Country places within 48h following the conclusion of the Confederation Boxing Championships 2018 of its continent.

Confirmation Process for Quota

Following the qualifying events, AIBA will officially inform the respective National Federations of the names of boxers who have gained qualification places.

Each National Federation involved in this process is requested to confirm within 2 weeks, by official letter to AIBA, whether or not they accept the quota places.

Once confirmed by their National Federation, qualified boxers will be automatically registered in the AIBA database by AIBA for the AIBA Youth Men and Women World Boxing Championships 2018.

Reallocation of Unused Quota Places

Reallocation of Unused Qualification Places:

If an allocated quota place from any Continental Qualifying Event is declined or not confirmed by a National Federation within the deadline, the unused quota place will be reallocated to the next best ranked eligible boxer, in the same weight category from the respective Continental Qualifying Event.

If the quota place declined by the eligible boxer, it will be reallocated to the Universality Place.

Reallocation of Unused Host Country Places:

Unused Host Country Place(s) will be reallocated to the next best ranked eligible boxer, in the same weight category from the respective Continental Qualifying Event.

If the quota place declined by the eligible boxer, it will be reallocated to the Universality Place.
