

# RECOMMENDATIONS ON DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME



## R&J COMMITTEE





- Successful delivery of 1, 2 and 3 Star R&J Courses (Dubai/Italy/Saudi Arabia/Croatia)
  - Refresh of course content, to include Ethics and Behaviour Education complete
- Referee and Judge Core Model Version 1 complete
- AIBA Referee and Judges Manual Version 1 refresh to include the Code of Ethics
  - Code of Conduct/Professional Standards currently under review with the AIBA Legal Team
- AIBA Auditor framework design (to build into the AIBA Strategy and Vision) –
   agreement required with the Board of Directors
- AIBA Instructor/Toolkit AIBA R&J Instructor Course currently under review (to include specialist instructional techniques)

#### International Boxing Association

#### Referees & Judges Committee

- Urgent requirement for ITOs/Evaluators/Observers/Instructors
  - 'Extra-Ordinary' bespoke course which allows attendance by approximately 12-15 personnel over a 7-day period
  - In line with Competition Chair proposal for a vetting process for AIBA competitions by specialised independent Assessment partner.
  - Fair objective No Corruption Good Lifestyle High Potential for the Role
- Initial 3\* 'new' R&J Certification How? Why?
  - AIBA Strategy and Vision (database and background checks)
  - E-learning portal to be developed (funding requirement) 'high potential for the role'
  - SME advice and guidance to support online project
    - To support language translations and online question set
    - Future ongoing physical assessments and examinations (locations to be confirmed)
- AIBA Auditor 'to support transitional work across all changes to course content'



# COMPETITIONS COMMITTEE

#### **Competitions Committee**



- All AlBA Officials must go through the Assessment Centre (TBC) in the future, this
  will be the absolute prerequisite for appointments to officiate as an AlBA Official at
  AlBA competitions;
- Elaboration of special criteria system used to choose AIBA Officials and Instructors in a special Assessment Centre following 3 main selection criteria:

No corruption / Good lifestyle / High potential for the job;

- Revision of the AIBA Technical and Competition Rules
- Unification of all training systems of AIBA (ITO, RJ, Coach, Doctor, Cutman);

#### **Competitions Committee**



- Tightening the Code of Conduct for AIBA Officials;
- Introduction of an Ombudsman who can anonymously review bouts to verify if there were any AIBA rules violation and other misconducts;
- Revision of the Bidding Book creation / Improvement of Bidding Processes for AIBA World Boxing Championships and High-Level Competitions;
- Organize cross-committee meetings to work closely together with the most urgent issues in order to take faster and more efficient decisions.



# COACHES COMMITTEE

#### **Coaches Committee**



- E-learning: online courses and webinars for the Coaches to update the level;
- Appointment of National level Instructors and creating Basics Manual for NFs to launch 1-Star Coaches Courses;
- Multilingual and multicultural courses to provide more courses at national level in local languages taking into account cultural features;
- Updating Instructor Pool through adding more experienced people, including Instructors for the Instructor Course (as instructors of the instructors);
- Collaboration with Universities to keep on track with development;

#### **Coaches Committee**



- Regular meetings in Teams-Coaches, Instructors, Confederations to carry on the work with the programs in between the meetings;
- Development of *AIBA Youtube channel* for video tutorials and exercise folders for coaches and boxers;
- Updating manuals and training materials;
- Introduction of 4-star (instructor for national level) and 5-star (mentor, instructor for international level);
- Elaboration of Code of Conduct for Coaches.



### WOMEN'S COMMITTEE

#### **Women's Committee**



- Women's Aspire Program the courses for female Coaches, R&J, ITO's, doctors and sport managers across all 5 confederations. The pilot project to be held in the Assisi Academy in late autumn 2021;
- Boxer to Coach/R&J/ITO: at Elite Women championships there should be a development programme ran alongside the championships for those boxers who are not able to continue her career as an active athlete;

#### **Women's Committee**



- Women's Committee Webinar educational webinars for AIBA & Confederations Women's Committee members on various topics on a regular basis;
- Women's Community of Practice 2-4 sessions per year for female Coaches. R&J, ITO's and Administrators for each group to come together for a networking opportunity and to explore different topics for discussions.



# MEDICAL & ANTI-DOPING COMMITTEE

#### **Medical & Anti-Doping Committee**



- Educating active doctors to deliver Ring-Side Doctor and Cutmen courses;
- Forming and updating the list of all active doctors from NFs, rating them (e.g. National Doctor, working in Continental championship etc.);
- Organize Refreshment Course for certified doctors and cutmen;
- Create an electronic database of medical history and all medical examinations;
- Organize First-Aid Course for Coaches within the championships as well as a separate Course for Cutmem.
