4. COVID-19 PROTOCOL

The event is approved as professional sport event with a very strict countermeasure concept and therefore the AIBA Event Management Protocol during COVID-19 pandemicwill be implemented. According to the current COVID-19 situation in the Host City at thetime of the Championships, there will be an update regarding all the requirements and protocols to be followed. The following is what will be mandatory, regardless of the situation:

- Every Participant need to bring a negative Covid-19 PCR test upon arrival to Belgrade. Please check https://www.mfa.gov.rs/en/citizens/travel-serbia for the time requirement as per your country.
- Nobody is allowed to leave the hotel at any time during the tournament period.
- Masks must be worn at all times in the areas recommended LOC and COVID-19 Managers.
- Distance minimum 1,5m at any time.
- Disinfection fluid and hand sanitizers must be used as often as possible.
- For breakfast, lunch and dinner, teams will get a timeslot.
- Temperature measurement for all participants every day.
- Rapid tests will be done randomly for all groups of participants.









5. COMPETITION

A. Format

The Championships will be run based on AIBA Technical Rules and AOB Competition Rules.

• Thirteen weight categories will be contested:

- There will be no seeding due to the change and increase in the number of weight categories
- Note on gloves: As per the amendment to the AIBA Technical & Competition Rule
 44.6. In AOB Elite and Youth Men's Competitions:
 - 44.6.1. Ten (10) oz gloves must be used for the Minimumweight (46-48kg) category to the Welterweight (67kg) category.
 - 44.6.2. Twelve (12) oz gloves must be used for the Light Middleweight (71kg) category to Super Heavyweight (92+ kg) category.
- The Bout Review Rule (AIBA Technical & Competition Rule no. 20) will be allowed.
- The Official Draw will be conducted by Swiss Timing through an electronic draw.
- Two rings will be used until the semi-finals phase.
- Medals will be distributed to the first 4 boxers of each weigh category (1 Gold, 1 silver,2 Bronze).
- The Technical Delegate of the event is Mr. Marko Marovic.
- The Event will be officiated by AIBA International Technical Officials and AIBA 3- Star certified Referees and Judges, all appointed by AIBA.









B. Prize Money

Prize money will be awarded in each category as follows:

C. Sport Entries Check

The Sport Entries Check will take place on October 23 and 24, 2021. Teams will be informed of the exact date and time of their appointment during accreditation after arrival. Please make sure to arrive in Belgrade, Serbia on or prior to October 22, 2021.

Each Team delegation can appoint a maximum of 2 persons to attend the Sport EntriesCheck. AIBA recommends to each team to send the Team Manager and/or the Team Doctor and/or the Head Coach.

Each Team Delegation's representatives will have a 10-minute appointment with AIBA Officials to confirm the entry list of their delegation, the spelling of boxers' names, the uniforms, national flag and anthem and to present the official documents listed below to AIBA.

Your representative(s) must present:

- 1. Entry list of the delegation
- 2. Passports of each boxer.
- 3. Record Books of each boxer.
- 4. Uniform examples.
- 5. Results of Hepatitis B, Hepatitis C and HIV tests, not older than 12 months (boxers)
- 6. AIBA General Participation Form signed by all team members
- 7. AIBA Men's World Championships Code of Conduct signed by all team members
- 8. AIBA Medical certificates issued within the last 3 months for each boxer.
- 9. COVID-19 Declaration of No symptoms Form signed by all team members
- 10.COVID-19 Liability Waiver Form signed by all team members
- 11. Anti-doping consent forms signed by each of the boxers.
- 12. Video consent form signed by team manager/head coach.

Important: Please note that the presence of your representative is mandatory. In the event where Team Delegation Representatives do not show-up to the scheduled appointment, the entire Team will be disqualified. ALL MEDICAL DOCUMENTS MUST BE PRESENTED (Medical Certificate; HIV, Hepatitis B & C results)

6. **REGISTRATIONS**

A. Participating Boxers

AGE ELIGIBILITY: Boxers born from January 01,1981 to December 31, 2002

Each National Federation is invited to register up to one (1) boxer in each weight category, as per AIBA Technical and Competition Rules, and National Federations may also register a reserve boxer for each of the weight categories. All registrations need to be done through the AIBA database (https://www.aiba-database.org/nf).

B. Team Officials

Each Team Delegation can have the following number of Team Officials:

- 1 Team Manager
- 1 Team Doctor
- 1 Physiotherapist
- 1 AIBA Certified Team Cutman
- Number of coaches according to the table below:

1 – 3 Boxers: Up to 4 Coaches 4 – 7 Boxers: Up to 5 Coaches 8 – 10 Boxers: Up to 6 Coaches 11 – 13 Boxers: Up to 8 Coaches

C. Coaches

Each Boxer will be entitled to be accompanied to the ring by up to three (3) coaches. However, only two (2) Coaches may mount the apron of the ring and only one (1) may enter the ring.

- All boxers must be accompanied by at least one AIBA certified coach (1, 2 or 3-Star) at ringside during the bouts.
- All Coaches allowed to work in the Field of Play (FOP) must be AIBA certified (1 to3-Star).
- One of the 3 coaches can be replaced by an AIBA Certified Team Cutman.

If your team does not have any AIBA certified coach (1,2 or 3-star), please raise this at the Technical Meeting, so arrangements can be made with another team.









D. Extra Officials

Any individual who will be at the event in addition to the ones outlined in point 4.b., whom the National Federation (NF) would like to send to work with the team, would be registered as an Extra Official.

Extra Officials who do not have a direct link with the preparation of the team for the competition will not receive an accreditation. Decisions will be taken by AIBA on a case bycase basis.

Each National Federation can register up to 6 additional persons within the following 2 categories:

- Extra Officials NF Representatives:
 - NF President
 - NF Secretary General
 - NF Executive Board Member
 - NF President Accompanying Guest
 - NF Administrative Staff
- Extra Officials Team Delegation Staff
 - National Coach of a registered boxer

 - Nutritionist

All Extra-Official registrations must be done through AIBA database in the dedicated section of the event.

In the event where one of your representatives has special security needs (personal security), please make sure to contact the LOC at wbc.belgrade2021@gmail.com, to arrange access, accreditation and entry into Serbia in accordance with local authorities



14. IMAGE RIGHTS

AIBA has appointed an AIBA photographer in order to promote the image of boxers duringthe World Championships. By participating in the Championships, each Boxer agrees to release his/her image rights to AIBA for promotional purposes.

15. DOPING CONTROL

Anti-doping controls will be conducted in accordance with the AIBA Anti-Doping Rules and the World Anti-Doping Code. We would like to remind you that according to WADA regulations, from 2016, blood testing may be conducted during AIBA Competitions.

TUE must be submitted through ADAMS system no later than October 01, 2021 (23:59GMT).

16. MEDICAL CARE

The LOC will provide medical care and first-aid during the entire Championships Period toany participant who suffers from a sports injury contracted during the Championships.

17. INSURANCE

All participants are requested to get their own travel and medical insurance as the LOC will provide liability insurance for all participants only at the Competition Venue.

18. AWARDS

Several awards, including the best boxer trophy of the AIBA Men's World Boxing Championships Belgrade, Serbia 2021 will be distributed after the last finals ceremony.









19. HOST CITY - BELGRADE

The capital of Serbia, Belgrade ("White Fortress" is a modernEuropean city which is known as "the city that never sleeps".



Belgrade is one of the oldest cities in Europe which is built at the confluence of two big rivers – the Danube and the Sava.

One of Belgraders' most popular picnic and excursion destinations is mount Avala – located not far from the city. The other is Ada Ciganlija, a river island turned into a peninsula with apromenade and a beach that surround the lake in the center.

The largest church in Southeastern Europe is the church of St. Sava, located in Belgrade'spart called Vracar, is the dome, which is 44 meters high, has a mosaic that represents the passage of Jesus Christ.



There is something for everybody: from modern restaurants, "splavs" (floating river clubs)which more than 170, alternative music clubs and theatres to famous "kafanas" (traditional Serbian taverns) of Skadarlija.

Skadarlija, the bohemian street, for a place where music and singing can be heard untildawn.













Kalemegdan Fortress is located at the confluence of Sava and Danube Rivers, in the OldTown. It is the most visited attraction in Belgrade, The Fortress is surrounded by Kalemegdan Park, the largest park and the most important historical monument in Belgrade.



One of the oldest landmarks in Belgrade is a street Knez Mihailova which is the main pedestrian street. Always full of life, filled with stores, cafes and restaurants, it is the bestplace to feel the pulse of Belgrade and admire the diverse architectural styles.









Everyone who decide to visit Belgrade should come to see Gardos, place where Zemun hasbegun it's legendary history. Gardoš Tower also known as The Tower of Janos Hunyadi (who actually died in the old fortress, 440 years before the tower was built) is a memorial towerlocated in Zemun.
