- Since 2009, GB Boxing boxers have won 87 major championship medals (European, World and Olympic).
- CEO for the British Lionhearts World Series Boxing (WSB) franchise and member of the AIBA WSB Commission.
- Chair of the organising committee for the European Qualification Tournament for Tokyo 2020, hosted in London.
- Secured significant sponsorship deals with Sting and Nike.

- Member of UK Sport committee for people development and director of GB Sport Media.
- Worked for Sport England, the government agency for grassroots sport, managing £20m annual investment into national federations, including boxing, football and cycling.
