The meeting will be hosted in a **hybrid format** with the online meeting platform Zoom being used for those who will attend the Congress online.

In this case, we will cover the travel and accommodation for the voting delegates. Please note that the Congress registration was closed on 31st October and no changes to the delegates will be permitted.
