1. ORGANISER

The South African National Boxing Organisation (SANABO) is affiliated to the International Boxing Association (IBA) and African Boxing Confederation (AFBC). SANABO has been entrusted with the organization of the Mandela African Boxing Cup competition. This competition is opened to all African national federations.

3. REGISTRATION TO THE COMPETITION

All registrations for Team Delegations will have to be made through IBA DATABASE The registrations are open from **21 September to 28 September 2023.**

4. COVID-19 PROTOCOL

The event is approved as a sporting event. The Covid-19 situation is very dynamic, therefore, an update regarding all requirements and protocols will be provided if the situation changes.









5. COMPETITION

а. Format

- The new IBA Bout Review Rule will be applied.
 The Official Draw will be conducted by Sportdata through an electronic draw.
 Two rings will be used until the semi-finals phase.









- Medals will be distributed to the first 4 boxers of each weigh category (1 Gold, 1 silver, 2 Bronze).
- The Technical Delegate of the event is yet to be decided.
- The Event will be officiated by IBA International Technical Officials and IBA certified Referees and Judges, all appointed by IBA in partnership with AFBC.
- World and Olympic Champions can have their name written in Gold on their back, and all boxers must have their country code written in white on their back along with their surname.

We encourage everyone to do this in advance, however, printing services will be provided on-site for those who cannot.

IBA Elite Weight Categories:

The competition will be organised based on the IBA Technical and Competition Rules. Women boxers between the age of 18 and 40 according to their year of birth (born between **January 1**, **1983 – December 31, 2004**) will be eligible to compete in the following 12 weight categories:

AFBC is in discussion with IBA and the conclusion will be published very soon. Meanwhile, an athlete must win at least one bout in order to be eligible to earn the designated prize money. In the case that only one athlete is present in the category, or he will not be eligible to benefit from the prize money.

To avoid doubt:

a. If the athlete has a win by Walkover (WO), and is a medalist, this athlete is entitled to receive prize money.

b. If the athlete has a loss and no wins, and is a medalist, this athlete is not entitled to receive prize money.

c. Medals

AFBC and the Local organizing committee will distribute for each of the different weight categories:

- 1st Place: gold medal (1)
- 2nd Place: silver medal (1)







- 3rd Place: bronze medal (1)
- 4th Place: bronze medal (1)

d. Sport Entries Check

The Sport Entries Check will take place on 08 October 2023. Teams will be informed of the exact date and time of their appointment during accreditation after arrival. Please make sure to arrive in Durban, South Africa by 8th October 2023 at the latest.

Each Team delegation can appoint a maximum of 2 persons to attend the Sport Entries Check. IBA recommends to each team to send the Team Manager and/or the Team Doctor and/or the Head Coach.

Each Team Delegation's representatives will have a 10-minute appointment with IBA Technical Officials to confirm the entry list of their delegation, the spelling of boxers' names, the uniforms, national flag and anthem and to present the official documents listed below to IBA.

Your representative(s) must present the following:

- 1. Entry list of the delegation
- 2. Passport of each boxer.
- 3. Record Book of each boxer.
- 4. Boxer's uniform examples.
- 5. Results of Hepatitis B, Hepatitis C and HIV tests, not older than 6 months
- 6. IBA Medical certificates issued within the last 30 days for each boxer.
- 7. IBA Fit to Box form (all boxers).
- 8. COVID-19 Declaration of No symptoms Form signed by all team members.
- 9. COVID-19 Liability Waiver Form signed by all team members.
- 10. Anti-doping consent forms signed by each boxer.
- 11. Video consent form signed by team manager/head coach.
- 12. IBA General Participation Form
- 13. Declaration of non-pregnancy
- 14. IBA Code of Conduct

Important: Please note that the presence of your representative is mandatory. In the event where Team Delegation Representatives do not show-up to the scheduled appointment, the entire Team will be disqualified. **ALL MEDICAL DOCUMENTS MUST BE PRESENTED**

Calendar and competition schedule may be changed or adjusted after general weight-in and official draw.

6. SPORT ENTRY CHECK

- 6.1 All Boxers must bring the following items to the General Weigh-In:
 - Filled Declaration of Non-pregnancy (for women boxers)
- 6.2 Each Team Delegation must bring the following:
 - National flag 1 x 1.5m
 - National anthem on MP3 or CD
- 6.3 Boxer's Uniform:
 - Each Boxer must bring two sets of uniform (complete red and blue color sets not being mixed with any other color)
 - Boxers must wear a same color set of either red or blue form fitting vest and shorts/skirts as per the Boxers' respective corner allocation which will be their own responsibility
 - The belt line of any shorts/skirts must be clearly indicated by a contrasting color and by using a 6-10 cm wide elastic waistband (the belt line is an imaginary line from the navel to the top of the hips).
 - Bring Hair-net/bandana (for women boxers)

7. OFFICIAL BOXING EQUIPMENT

All official boxing equipment for the Mandela African Boxing Cup Men and Women Boxing Competitionin Durban 2023 will be provided by IBA Official Licensee









8. **REGISTRATIONS**

a. Participating Boxers

Each National Federation is invited to register up to one (1) boxer in each weight category, as per IBA Technical and Competition Rules. All registrations need to be done through the IBA database (<u>https://iba-database.sport/nf</u>)

b. Team Officials

Each Team Delegation can have the following number of Team Officials:

- 1 Team Manager
- 1 Team Doctor
- 1 Physiotherapist
- 1 IBA Certified Team Cutman
- Number of coaches according to the table below:
 - 1–3 Boxers: Up to 3 Coaches
 - 4–8 Boxers: Up to 6 Coaches
 - $\circ \quad$ 9 13 Boxers: Up to 8 Coaches

c. Coaches

Each Boxer will be entitled to be accompanied to the ring by up to three (3) coaches.

However, only two (2) Coaches may mount the apron of the ring and only one (1) may enter the ring.

- Only IBA-certified Coaches (1-star to 3-star) are allowed to work in the Field of Play (FOP)
- One of the 3 coaches can be replaced by an IBA Certified Team Cutman.

If your team does not have any IBA certified coach (1,2 or 3-star), please raise this at the Technical Meeting, so arrangements can be made with another team.









d. Extra Team Officials & National Federation Representatives

- Any individual who will be at the event in addition to the ones outlined in point 4.b., whom the National Federation (NF) would like to send <u>to work with the team</u>, would be registered as an Extra Team Official.
- Extra Team Officials who do not have a direct link with the preparation of the team for the competition will not receive an accreditation.
- Extra Team Officials means:
 - National Coach of a registered boxer
 - Additional Physiotherapist
 - Additional Doctor
 - Nutritionist

NF Representatives

Any individual attending the event as a representative of the NF, such as:

- NF President
- NF Secretary General
- NF Executive Board Member
- NF President Accompanying Guest
- NF Administrative Staff

Each National Federation can register up to a total of 6 additional persons within the 2 categories named above.

All Extra Team Officials and National Federation Representatives registrations must be done through IBA database in the dedicated section of the event.

In the event where one of your representatives has special security needs (personal security), please make sure to contact the LOC at loc@sanabo.org to arrange access, accreditation and entry into South Africa in accordance with local authorities.

Important: If you plan to bring more than 6 additional persons, please note that accreditations will not be provided.

- Team delegations who needs Visas must immediately request it to South African Embassy / Consulate in their country. LOC will provide invitation letters for all Teams Delegations.
- LOC will provide landing visa letters for all Team Delegation who doesn't have South African Embassy / Consulate in their own country.
- Visa cost: 26 USD

In this case please contact immediately **Mrs Nomkhosi Ndlovu** and provide her with valid passport copies of the applicant(s) before **24 September 2023.** Please note that after this deadline the LOC cannot grant any Visa.

10. TRANSPORTATION

All participants are requested to get their own travel and medical insurance, as the LOC will provide liability insurance for all participants only at the Competition Venue.









15. TECHNICAL VIDEO RECORDING

Each National Federation will be allowed to record the bout of their boxers with up to one camera per ring. Two specific locations in the stands will be reserved for these technical areas. Recordings are for technical purposes only and not for public broadcasting, social media included. The access to the two technical video recording areas will be conditioned to the signature of a disclaimer in this regard. The team managerof each National federation must bring the signed copy to the Sport Entries Check.

16. IMAGE RIGHTS

IBA has appointed an IBA photographer to promote the image of boxers during the Championships. By participating in the Championships, each Boxer agrees to release their image rights to IBA for promotional purposes.

17. DOPING CONTROL

Anti-doping controls will be conducted in accordance with the IBA Anti-Doping Rules and the World Anti-Doping Code. We want to remind you that according to WADA regulations, from 2016, blood testing may be conducted during IBA Competitions.

TUE must be submitted through the ADAMS system no later than the18 September 2023.

18. MEDICAL CARE

The LOC will provide medical care and first-aid during the entire Championships Period to any participant who suffers from a sports injury contracted during the Championships.

19. INSURANCE

All participants are requested to get their own travel and medical insurance.

20. AWARDS

Medals and special awards will be distributed after the last finals ceremony.
