(hereinafter also referred to as "*Candidate*")


Decision:

1. In accordance with the Article 27.4 of the IBA Constitution and Article 25.3 of AFBC's Article of Association, the Boxing Independent Integrity Unit – Nomination Unit (hereinafter also referred to as "*Nomination Unit*") is competent to decide whether a Candidate is eligible for the African Boxing Confederation ("AFBC") Presidential Elections and membership of IBA Board of Directors.
2. The Nomination Unit has reviewed the application documents submitted by the Candidate and reports submitted by the independent vetting firm under the authority set out above.
3. After these reviews, the Nomination Unit requested additional clarification from the Candidate on 25.09.2023 and the additional clarifications of the Candidate were submitted on 28.09.2023.
4. As per the reports submitted by the vetting firm, it has been determined that the Candidate has some criminal records in his past and has been sanctioned by a number of countries. As stated above, although he was asked for an explanation regarding these findings, he did not provide any explanation with proofs. For these reasons, the Nomination Unit concluded as follows.
5. Following a review by the Nomination Unit, it has been determined that candidate **Mr. Ferdinand Ilunga Luyoyo's** does not meet the requirements of Article 27.8 of



the IBA Constitution and that the Candidate is **INELIGIBLE** for the AFBC Presidential Election.
