2025 IBA Ordinary Congress – Calling Notice

Dear Presidents and Secretaries General,

In accordance with Article 18.2 of the IBA Constitution, we hereby announce the convening of the Ordinary Congress meeting, as mandated by the Board, during the last quarter of each calendar year. We are pleased to inform you that the 2025 IBA Ordinary Congress is scheduled to take place on **13 December 2025**, in a **hybrid format in Dubai, United Arab Emirates (UAE)**.

The registration of delegates for the IBA Ordinary Congress will commence on 15 August 2025 and conclude on 15 October 2025. To ensure representation at the 2025 IBA Ordinary Congress meeting, National Federations must notify the IBA Head Office of the names of their intended Voting Delegate and any Non-voting Delegate(s) **by 15 October 2025, 18:00 (CET – Central European Time)**, through the registration of their delegates for the Congress.


Additionally, we draw your attention to Article 20.1 of the IBA Constitution, which allows for the submission of proposals. Should your Federation have any proposals, kindly submit them to the IBA Head Office no later than 13 October 2025. Each proposal should be accompanied by an explanation of the item and the reasons prompting its inclusion in the Congress's Agenda.

The final agenda, including any motions or Constitution amendments, will be communicated to you no later than one month prior to the Congress. Voting for these motions/amendments will be facilitated through a secure voting platform accessible to both in-person and online delegates.

The list of eligible National Federations participating and voting at the Ordinary Congress, in compliance with Article 16 of the IBA Constitution, will be published on the IBA website accordingly.

Your full participation and valued suggestions are eagerly anticipated.
