# 3. COMPETITION

The Championships will be organized in accordance with the IBA Technical and Competition Rules.

## A. Age Eligibility and Weight Categories

### U23 MEN

- Age: 19 – 22 years old (born from January 01, 2007 to December 31, 2004).
- 13 Weight Categories: 46-48kgs, 51kgs, 54kgs, 57kgs, 60kgs, 63,5kgs, 67kgs, 71kgs, 75kgs, 80kgs, 86kgs, 92kgs, +92kgs.

### U23 WOMEN

- Age: 19 – 22 years old (born from January 01, 2007 to December 31, 2004).
- 12 Weight Categories: 45-48kgs, 50kgs, 52kgs, 54kgs, 57kgs, 60kgs, 63kgs, 66kgs, 70kgs, 75kgs, 81kgs, +81kgs.

## YOUTH MEN

- Age: 17 – 18 years old (born from January 01, 2008 to December 31, 2009).
- 13 Weight Categories: 46-48kgs, 51kgs, 54kgs, 57kgs, 60kgs, 63,5kgs, 67kgs, 71kgs, 75kgs, 80kgs, 86kgs, 92kgs, +92kgs.

## YOUTH WOMEN

- Age: 17 – 18 years old (born from January 01, 2008 to December 31, 2009).
- 45-48kgs, 50kgs, 52kgs, 54kgs, 57kgs, 60kgs, 63kgs, 66kgs, 70kgs, 75kgs, 81kgs, +81kgs

## B. Format

**U23 Men and Women:** Three (3) rounds of three (3) minutes each, one (1) minute of rest between rounds.

**Youth Men and Women:** Three (3) rounds of three (3) minutes each, one (1) minute of rest between rounds.

- The Official Draw will be conducted through an electronic random draw.
- Medals will be distributed to the first four (4) boxers in each weight category (1 gold, 1 silver, 2 bronze).
- The Championships will be officiated by IBA certified International Technical Officials and IBA certified 2 - 3\* R/Js.
- 10-must point system will be used.

## C. Prize Money

IBA will award prize money in each weight category (subject to a number of key factors) and as follows:

Medal	Prize Money
Gold	USD 1000
Silver	USD 500
Bronze	USD 250
Bronze	USD 250

The IBA Asian U23 & Youth Open Boxing Championships in Jakarta 2026 will offer USD 100.000 (one hundred thousand) in Prize Money, distributed across 13 male and 12 female U23 and Youth weight categories, to gold, silver and bronze medalists.

To be eligible for Prize Money, an athlete must win at least one bout. Prize Money will not be awarded if one one athlete competed in a weight category.

**For clarification:**

- Medalists winning by Wolkover (WO) will receive prize money
- Medalists without a bout or no wins will not receive prize money.

## 4. SPORT ENTRIES CHECK

The Sport Entries Check (SEC) is scheduled for a full day on April 5, 2026, and for the morning of April 6, 2026, at the Team’s Hotel (the hotel name will be provided at a later date). Attendance at the SEC is mandatory for all Team Delegations. The exact date and time for each delegation’s appointment will be communicated during the accreditation process upon arrival.

Each Team Delegation may appoint a maximum two (2) representatives (Team Manager and/or Team Doctor and/or Head Coach) to attend Sport Entries Check.

Each Team Delegation representative will have a 10-minute appointment with ITOs to confirm the entry list of their delegation, uniform, national flag and anthem, and to present the official documents listed below:

- Entry list of a Delegation.
- Passport of each Boxer.

- Record Book of each Boxer (Medical and Annual Medicals must be completed correctly, signed and stamped by a doctor).
- Boxer's Uniform (red and blue), robe and black sport form fitting-hijab (if applicable). The belt line of any shorts/skirt must be clearly identified by a contrasting color and must be 6 – 10 cm wide. The belt line is an imaginary line from the navel to the top of the hips and must not cover the navel.
- Results of Hepatitis B, Hepatitis C and HIV tests not older than 6 months.
- IBA Medical Certificate for each Boxer (issued within the last 30 days).
- Declaration of non-pregnancy signed by a legal guardian.
- Video Consent Form signed by Team Manager/Head Coach.
- Image Rights Consent Form signed by Team Manager/Head Coach.
- IBA Code of Conduct.
- National flag (1m x 1,5m) and anthem (on USB/CD in mp3 format).
- Hair net/bandana.

**Please note that if your representatives DO NOT show up to the scheduled appointment, the entire team will not be able to take part in the competition.**

## 5. REGISTRATION

Registration is opened from February 10, 2026 to March 22, 2026.

Each National Federation must register its Team Delegation through the IBA Database:

Each National Federation is invited to register a maximum one (1) entry boxer and one (1) reserve boxer in each weight category.

## A. Team Composition:

- Team Manager: 1
- 1–3 boxers: up to 2 coaches, 1 doctor, 1 physiotherapist, 1 cutman
- 4–7 boxers: up to 3 coaches, 1 doctor, 1 physiotherapist, 1 cutman
- 8–11 boxers: up to 5 coaches, 1 doctor, 1 physiotherapist, 1 cutman
- 12–20 boxers: up to 8 coaches, 1 doctor, 1 physiotherapist, 1 cutman
- 21–25 boxers: up to 10 coaches, 1 doctor, 1 physiotherapist, 1 cutman
- Extra Person: Open

## B. Coaches and Team R/Js

- Each Boxer may be accompanied to the ring by up to three (3) Coaches.
- Only two (2) Coaches may mount the apron of the ring and only one (1) may enter the ring.
- All boxers must be accompanied to the ring by at least one (1) certified (1, 2, 3 Star) Coach.
- Only IBA certified Coaches (1, 2, 3 Star) are allowed to work in the Field of Play (FOP).
- Any Coach of a National Level (not certified) will not be allowed to enter the FOP.
- If your team doesn't have any IBA Certified Coach (1, 2 or 3 Star), please raise this issue at the Technical Meeting, so the arrangements can be made with another team.
- All R/Js are to be nominated by their respective NFs and approved by the IBA Referee & Judge Committee. Liaison to take place through both the IBA Asia representative, and confirmed by the IBA Head Office (Development Department).
- R/Js nominated by NFs must be IBA certified (2 Star and above).
- NF must pay/cover for the airfare of its approved R/J, whilst the LOC will provide the local transportation, accommodation, meals and per diem.

# 6. ISA & ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

LOC will provide all necessary visa support assistance.

## **11. MEDICAL INSURANCE**

All participants are requested to acquire their own Medical and Travel insurance for the full duration of the event; from initial travel to arrival post tournament to respective home destinations.

## **12. MEDICAL CARE**

The LOC will provide Medical care and immediate First-aid during the entire event to any participant who requires support during the Championships.

## **13. ANTI-DOPING CONTROL**

Anti-Doping control will be conducted in accordance with the IBA Anti-Doping Rules and the World Anti-Doping Code during the IBA Asian U23 and Youth Men & Women Open Boxing Championships Jakarta 2026. Post event checks will be conducted as appropriate and as required.
